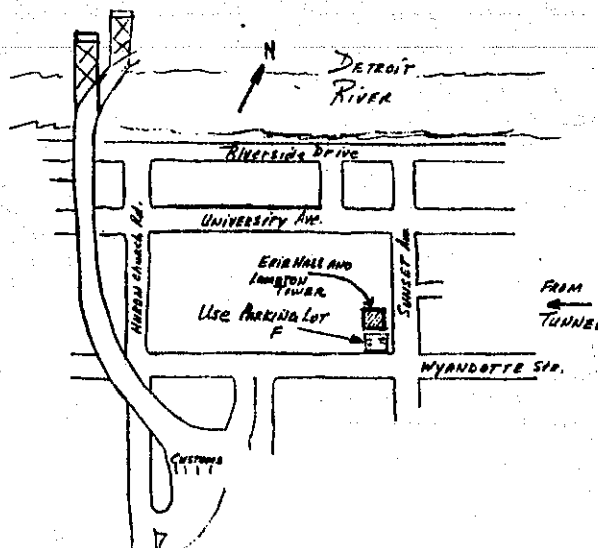
SUBJECT: 'COMPONENT vs COMPOSITE SYSTEMIZATION'
